## [New regulation on customs enforcement of IPR is proposed by the Commission](#)

In the context of its new IPR strategy, the European Commission has published a [proposal](#) for a new regulation on customs. This new regulation is aimed at improving the current legal framework in order to “*strengthen the enforcement of intellectual property rights, as well as to ensure appropriate legal clarity, thereby taking into account developments in the economic, commercial and legal areas.*” Once adopted by the European Parliament and the Council, Regulation (EC) No 1383/2003 that is in force since 1 July 2004 should be repealed.
